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INFORMATION AND TOURNAMENT POLICIES

Eligibility

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who:

- Are a resident of Oklahoma
- Will not have reached their 18th birthday by midnight July 10, 2010
- No handicap requirement or limit

Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during championship) by W OGA.

The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

Registration and Free Practice Round

Sunday, July 11, 2010 from 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. at Willow Creek Clubhouse.

Tournament Tee Times will be available at registration.

Entry Deadline & Refunds

Entry Deadline is Wednesday, July 7, 2010.

Entrants must use WOGA entry form. Entry fee is \$60.00 and will not be refunded after **July 7, 2009**.

(Entry fee includes \$10.00 WOGA Junior Membership. Deduct if currently a member.)

Format

Ages 12-17: 36 holes Stroke Play

Ages 11 & under: 18 Hole Stroke Play

Flights: 12-13 yrs; 14-15 yrs; 16-17 yrs (18 Holes/day).

11 & under (9 Holes/day);

Prizes

Winner: Winner's Trophy and custody of the Championship Trophy for one year.

Runner-Up: Runner-up Trophy

Third Place: Third Place Trophy

Caddies

A player may provide her own caddie. A player may not use a parent or guardian as caddie. Neither caddies nor players may use automotive transportation during play.

Rules of Golf

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf. Questions shall be settled by the Rules Committee whose decision will be final.

Awards Ceremony & Lunch

Lunch will be provided for the players, parents and caddies following play on Monday, July 12th and for the players, only, on Tuesday, July 13th.

The trophy presentation will be immediately following play on July 13th. Special Awards and Events!!

Practice Rounds

A free practice round will be allowed on Sunday , July 11, 2010 after 2 pm. Call 405-685-7611 one week prior and ask to reserve a tee-time. Players who are unable to practice at that time must make their own arrangements.

Dress Code

A dress code will be enforced at the golf course and during the use of the golf practice areas.

Participants and caddies must wear appropriate attire. Traditional golf shirts, slacks, skirts and

shorts are acceptable. WOGA Jr. Girls must wear collared, golf style shirts and/or sleeveless golf

shirts. No tank tops or halter tops. All skirts and shorts must be no shorter than four inches above

the knee. No blue jeans or denim may be worn. Caddies' golf shirts must have a collar, sleeves, and

be tucked in. No metal spikes allowed. The Rules Committee has the final say.
